How To Enter Images In Competitions

Check toledo.virtualpursuits.com: Organization>TCC Bylaws for complete bylaws. Our schedule shows dates when to enter and when competitions are presented. The three experience levels for members to compete in are:

- Beginner Group • Intermediate Group • Advanced Group

The 5 divisions of inter-club competition available for members are:

- **Prints** - any subject, monochrome and/or color prints (judged separately)
- **Digital Nature Images** - nature subjects, presented as seen in nature, not indoors, must show no human elements, no cultivated plants, no domestic animals, etc.; color only
- **Digital General Images** - any subject that shows the human element such as people, buildings, roads, cultivated plants, domestic animals, etc.; color only
- **Digital Creative Images** - any subject, must show image of altered reality by OBVIOUS manipulation in the computer, not a straight photo; ALL components of the creative entry must be that of the member; color & may have some monochrome areas
- **Digital Monochrome Images** - any subject; black & white, or black & white with 1 tone applied to the entire image, e.g. sepia toning



Use creative tools to enhance architecture to make it extreme, going beyond normal. All work and adjustments must be that of the member, no totally automated AI software use. Use layers, blends, or filters to enhance the image.

Night Shot- image taken after the sun is well below the horizon Autumn- highlight this season in nature Light Refraction- a table-top image using container(s) of water that shows refraction (bending of light); choose a background or item submerged in the water that will emphasize the refraction. Search "Light Refraction Art" for ideas but be original In Motion- Image must highlight motion. Motion can be inherent to original capture or motion can be added using creative techniques. All work and adjustments must be that of the member, no totally automated AI software use. Use layers, blends, filters, or brushes to enhance image.
